

Early Spring Lawn Program

Your early spring application contains a specially blended fertilizer to maximize spring green up. The pre-emergent in the fertilizer helps to control crabgrass and spurge as they germinate. Broadleaf weeds have been treated as needed.

Watering:

Please refrain from watering for 30 minutes after application. A light rain or snow will not affect this application. Remember, our granular fertilizer will be activated with watering, but will not burn your lawn if you do not water. As the weather becomes warmer and drier, water every 2-3 Days.

Mowing:

Early spring watering along with your first mowing at a lower setting can help the lawn recover from winter stress of the season. This also helps to pick-up matted grass and debris left over from the winter. For subsequent mowings, the mower height should be set at a mowing height of 2 1/2" to 3".

Cultural Notes:

Aeration is an important cultural practice. It allows water, nutrients and oxygen to reach your grass roots, in addition to loosening or breaking up compacted soils. Call Swingle to authorize an aeration for your lawn if you have not already done so.
