

Fall Lawn Program

Your fall/autumn application is the most important of the year. The specially blended fertilizer is designed to release slowly, providing the nutrients that your lawn will use to survive this winter and for maximum green-up next spring. Broadleaf weed control has been applied as needed.

Watering:

Please refrain from watering for 30 minutes after this application. A light rain or snow will not affect this application.

Mowing:

For the last couple of mowings in October, lower the blades to help prepare your lawn for winter. Make sure the blades are sharp before mowing.

Cultural Notes:

Rake up any leaves or twigs on your lawn before the snow begins to fall. As the winter progresses continue to water your lawn when you receive inadequate amounts of moisture. Pay special attention to sloped areas and south or west exposed areas of your lawn that receive more sunshine. These are the areas that are most susceptible to damage from mites or winterkill.

If you have had winter-kill or mite damage in the past, call Swingle to set-up a program for mite control applications throughout the winter.

When the snow melts during the winter, lightly rake up any matted areas. When shoveling snow, throw it back onto your lawn and around your trees and shrubs instead of into the street where the moisture is wasted.
